Introduction

Definition of Bullying

Prevention Strategies

1. Open Communication:

- Any incidents should be reported to Make It Happen Club SCIO management and all reports will be treated confidentiality.

2. Inclusive Culture:

- Promote an inclusive and welcoming environment that celebrates diversity and discourages discrimination.

- Emphasise the importance of mutual respect and understanding.

Reporting and Responding to Bullying Incidents

1. Reporting Procedure:



- Anyone who witnesses or experiences bullying is encouraged to report the incident promptly to a trusted staff member, volunteer, or through the designated reporting channels.

2. Confidentiality:

- Make It Happen Club SCIO will handle all reports with the utmost confidentiality, respecting the privacy of all parties involved.

3. Investigation and Action:

- Make It Happen Club SCIO will promptly and impartially investigate all reported incidents of bullying.

- Appropriate actions will be taken, ranging from counselling and education to disciplinary measures, depending on the severity and repetition of the behaviour.

4. Support for Targets:

- Make It Happen Club SCIO will provide support for individuals who have experienced bullying

Consequences for Bullying

Consequences for engaging in bullying behaviours may include verbal warnings, written warnings, suspension from Make It Happen Club SCIO activities, or, in severe cases, termination of association with Make It Happen Club SCIO. Make It Happen Club SCIO is committed to taking appropriate action to address bullying and prevent its recurrence.
